Thank you for your email of 30 July on behalf of your constituent, Charles Green of The Wood, Maesbrook, Oswestry, about my visit to the area in July. I apologise for the delay in responding. Defra is currently dealing with high volumes of correspondence.

I am sorry we did not have the opportunity to meet when I visited. I understand Mr Green was disappointed he was not able to meet me directly and I understand the Environment Agency's Area Director contacted him directly following the visit.

During my visit to the area I was fortunate to visit six sites. We had to limit the number of stakeholders joining each meeting to enable a full discussion in the limited time available at each location.

As Mr Green recognises, I did meet with a number of community representatives and councillors, which provided me with a useful insight into the difficulties residents are dealing with in the Melverley/Crew Green river confluence area.

Thank you for sharing Mr Green's information pack with me. I have shared this with the Environment Agency, and it will be able to consider the information pack as part of its investigations.

Across the visit I learnt more about the complexities of water management in the Severn catchment and related matters, including land management and development planning. Set against the challenge of climate change, this was a valuable opportunity to see the investment being made by a broad spectrum of partners to address all the interconnected concerns of water resources, water quality and flood risk management.

I wholeheartedly support this partnership approach in the Severn Catchment and look forward to seeing how it progresses.
