KINNERLEY PARISH COUNCIL CURRENTLY HAS A VACANCY FOR A COUNCILLOR IN THE EDGERLEY WARD

AN ELECTION HAS NOT BEEN REQUESTED, AND THE PARISH COUNCIL WILL THEREFORE NOW PROCEED TO FILL THE SEAT BY THE CO-OPTION OF A PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP.

THE PERSON MUST BE QUALIFIED BY VIRTUE OF BEING A BRITISH OR COMMONWEALTH CITIZEN, CITIZEN OF THE REPUBLIC OF IRELAND OR EUROPEAN UNION CITIZEN, WHO HAS ATTAINED THE AGE OF 18 YEARS AND IS:

- (a) Registered as a local government elector for the parish; and/or who has;
- (b) During the whole of the twelve months preceding the appointment occupied as owner or tenant land or other premises in the town; and/or his/her
- (c) Principal or only place of work during those twelve months has been in the town; and/or has;
- (d) During those twelve months resided in the town or within 4.8 kilometres of it;

And is not disqualified from holding office by reason of any disqualification set out in Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972.
