# 74.14 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST AND DISPENSATIONS

# 75.14 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION SESSION

A member of the public advised the Parish Council that he is concerned about the planning application for change of use of the agricultural land opposite the Hayloft in Edgerley. Hard standing has been installed over the Easter weekend and a caravan put on this. He had concerns about the possible use of the proposed large barn. He stated that the hard standing and the caravan was change of use and permission had not been obtained.

A member of the public stated that this change of use needs to be enforced against immediately and the assistance of the Parish Council was requested.

# Cllr B Cambidge left the meeting and took no part in the next agenda item

 i. 14/01703/OUT - Outline application for the erection of 18 no. dwellings to include means of access - Land Including Storage Buildings/offices Argoed Road Kinnerley SY10 8DH RESOLVED to suspend standing orders on two occasions to allow Peter Clarke and the applicant's agent to speak. The applicant's agent gave an overview of the proposal and answered questions from the Councillors.

Peter Clarke, Chairman of the Kinnerley Parish Neighbourhood Plan Steering Committee, spoke to say that he thought that if this site had been included as a proposed site during the KPNP consultation it would have been popular. He said that there is a difference/distinction between some of the current outrageous proposed developments and this proposal.

## **RESOLVED** to resume standing orders

# **RESOLVED** to make the following comment:

Kinnerley Parish Council supports this planning application but on the clear basis of no more than the proposed 18 houses. This site was not considered during the Kinnerley Parish Neighbourhood Plan community consultations and is outside the development boundary. However this is a sustainable location and therefore the Parish Council acknowledges that this application will be assessed against the policies in the National Policy Planning Framework (NPPF). If the Parish Council has to consider development outside of the development boundary then this would be the preferred site as it is a brownfield site in a sustainable location and not an undeveloped green field.

Any planning application for this site is asked to consider the issue of road safety at the Argoed junction and the main road passing the school, including where the proposed footpath crosses the road. There is limited visibility at the Argoed junction and road safety in this area is a concern as there will be increased traffic from the new homes.

## Cllr B Cambidge returned to the meeting

# 87.14 FOOTBALL PITCH

The Parish Council considered a request from the KPNP communities group for a dogs on lead sign and provision of litter bin on the football pitch. The rent payable by the rounders and football teams was also reviewed following a rent increase by the Diocese.

RESOLVED to make no change to the agreed rent payable by the rounders and football teams. It was noted that the field is covered by the Shropshire Council Dog Control Order and therefore dog fouling is an offence. The Clerk was asked to look into a dogs on lead sign for the field. The meeting was advised that a bin is already available on the pitch.

# 88.14 VEHICLE ACTIVATION SIGN IN KINNERLEY

The meeting was advised that funding had been withdrawn for the VAS in Kinnerley for 2014/15 onwards. Cllr A Walpole explained the current position and the Parish Council considered funding future provision.

RESOLVED to support in principle future provision of a VAS sign in Kinnerley subject to cost and consideration of reducing the amount of times the sign is moved around the local Parishes.
