#### 47.16 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

The following planning applications were considered.

**RESOLVED:** That the following comments be submitted to the Shropshire Council Planning Authority:

Cllr B Cambidge declared a disclosable pecuniary interest in the following agenda item and left the meeting without taking part in any discussion or vote relating to this planning application.

It was resolved to suspend Standing Orders prior to the Council's discussion to allow the developer to address the Parish council and answer questions. It was then resolved to resume Standing Orders.

i. 16/00902/REM - Approval of reserved matters (scale, appearance, landscaping and layout) pursuant to 14/01703/OUT for the residential development of 18 properties (including affordable), detached garages, public open space, estate roads - Storage Depot Kinnerley Oswestry Shropshire SY10 8DH

Comments: The Parish Council supports this application in principle, but would prefer a higher proportion of three bedroomed houses, in line with the Kinnerley Parish Neighbourhood Plan. It is therefore requested that three of the proposed four bedroomed houses are replaced with smaller three bedroomed properties instead. The existing hedge around the development should be retained/improved and not replaced with fencing.

#### Cllr B Cambidge returned to the meeting.

ii. 16/00775/OUT - Outline application (all matters reserved) for the erection of one dwelling and all associated works - Land to the East of Maesbrook Shropshire

Comments: The Parish Council objects to this application as the site is in an unsustainable location outside the development boundary and the proposed access is unacceptable as it is onto a stretch of road with dangerous bends on it.

Cllr B Jones declared a personal interest in the following agenda item and left the meeting without taking part in any discussion or vote relating to this planning application.

iii. 16/01080/FUL - Erection of 2 storey extension; single storey rear porch; demolition of lean-to toilet and existing rear porch and associated alterations and repairs - Little Duglands Edgerley Oswestry Shropshire SY10 8ER and 16/01081/LBC - Erection of 2 storey extension; single storey rear porch; demolition of lean-to toilet and existing rear porch and associated alterations and repairs affecting a Grade II Listed Building - Little Duglands Edgerley Oswestry Shropshire SY10 8ER

Comments: The Parish Council fully supports these applications for necessary work to rescue this property and update it for modern living.

## Cllr B Jones returned to the meeting

iv. 16/01014/FUL - Conversion of outbuilding to provide ancillary accommodation and erection of detached timber framed double garage - The Willows Farm Maesbrook Oswestry Shropshire SY10 8QY

Comments: The Parish Council supports this application.

 v. 16/00898/PMBPA - Application for prior approval under Part 3, Class Q of the Town & Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 for the conversion of two barns to form two residential units with all associated works; demolition of one barn - Barn At Grange Farm Edgerley Kinnerley Oswestry Shropshire SY10 8EP

Comments: The Parish Council objects to this application. The barns are modern steel shed structures which need substantial alterations in order to be converted into habitable dwellings. The works proposed would result in a significant departure of the original fabric and are considered unreasonable. The Parish Council does not consider this a barn conversion but rebuild of effectively а on the footprint а modern steel shed. The Parish Council has supported previous applications for barn conversions but does not support this proposal to effectively build new houses in an unsustainable location. This application fails to comply with the aims and aspirations of the Kinnerley Parish Neighbourhood Plan (which has been adopted by Shropshire Council as a material consideration for development management purposes). It is in open countryside, where new development is strictly controlled under policy CS5 of Shropshire Council's Core Strategy. Approval of this development would lead to sporadic and unsustainable development that would undermine the "rural rebalance" approach to development. This site is not identified in SAMDev for housing and is outside any development boundary. The application site is some distance from the development boundaries of Dovaston and Knockin Heath. At a national level, paragraph 55 of the National Planning Policy Framework (the Framework) confirms that isolated new homes in the countryside should be avoided. In terms of its location therefore, the proposal would represent an incursion into the open countryside and is contrary to local plan and national policies which seek to restrict development in such areas.

# 49.16 CENTENARY CLOSE – BANKFIELDS LANE

The meeting was advised that, following complaints, received by the Parish Council, about the removal of trees and a hedge adjoining Bankfields Lane and concerns that an existing fence line is to be moved, Cllr S Bruce, Cllr B Cambidge and the Clerk met with local residents at Bankfields Lane. Feedback from that site meeting was provided. The ongoing issues relating to planning conditions for this development were considered.

RESOLVED to write to Shropshire Council to support the concerns raised by a resident of Bankfields Lane about the lack of enforcement of planning conditions for this development. The Clerk was asked to report that the footpath to the rear of the development as becoming blocked by the overgrown hedge.
